DEATH

1. Types

- a. Spiritual Separation from God in Time; no fellowship with Him Rom. 6:23 Prov. 14:12; I Cor. 15-22; Rom. 5:12; Ezek. 18:20
- b. Physical Separation of body from soul and spirit, Phil. 1:21; John 11:25; Rom. 8:38; Job 19:25, 26; Psa. 23:4
- c. Second Separation from God in eternity Heb. 9:27; Rev. 20:11-15
- d. Positional Identified with Christ in His death Rom. 6:1-11; Col. 2:20
- e. Operational Faith without works James 2:26
- f. Temporal Out of temporal fellowship James 1:15; Rom. 3:2, 5, 13
- g. Sexual Incapable of procreating Rom. 4:17, 19; Heb. 11:12

2. Reasons for Christian Death

- a. Glorify the Lord John 21:19; Acts 7:51
- b. Finish work 2 Tim. 4:7; Rev. 11:7; Luke 23:46
- c. Discipline I Cor. 3:17; I John 5:16; I Cor. 11:30
- d. Human will over divine will suicide.

DISCIPLINE

(

- 1. Discipline is for the believer only Heb. 5, 6.
- 2. Is based on love Heb. 12:6.
- Never implies loss of salvation.
- 4. Is punishment for sins of the believer after salvation immediate vicinity.
- 5. Is removed by rebound or confession I Cor. 11:31; I John 1:9.
- 6. When suffering continues after rebound, the purpose is for blessing.
- All discipline is confined to time, not in eternity.
- 8. If you suspect suffering in your life and have rebounded, look for something near at hand.

<u>DYING GRACE</u> - Phil. 1:21; II Cor. 5:8; Rev. 21:4; I Peter 1:4.

ELECTION

- 1. Christ is elected from eternity past Isa. 42:1; 2 Tim. 1:9; I Peter 2:6.
- 2. This election took place in doctrine of eternal decrees I Pet. 1:2 on the basis of union with Christ Eph. 1:4; 2 II Thessa. 2:13.
- 3. Is present and future possession of all believers Cor. 3:12
- 4. Every believer shares Christ's election Rom. 8:28
- 5. Election takes place at moment of salvation I Cor. 1:9, 24, 26-28; 2 Thessa. 2:13.
- 6. Election is the foundation of the Church I Thessa. 1:4.
- 7. Is based on Grace Gal. 1:6; 5:8.
- 8. Is basis of facing suffering with blessing Rom. 8:28.
